

Sungevity Expanding Headquarters

Ascent Solar Enters Alliance

Ascent Solar Technologies Inc. says it has entered into a partnership with China-based TFG Radiant Group that includes investments by TFG Radiant in Ascent, as well as a joint development agreement to establish manufacturing facilities in East Asia.

Under the agreement, TFG Radiant has committed \$165 million for the initial East Asia fab. bringing the total deal value to about \$450 million plus royalties. This fab is expected to have an initial annual production capacity of 100 MW.

Trina Solar Receives Module Certificates
